WHO All members of volunteer, paid, or part-paid fire departments of cities and industries who need or wish to obtain state or national certification in accordance with NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications.

WHY To increase one's knowledge of various management and leadership abilities to effectively lead and manage fire service personnel both on and off the fire ground.

COURSE INFORMATION

NFPA 1021 Fire Officer III/IV Course meets Texas Commission on Fire Protection (TCFP) and ProBoard (NBFSPQ) certification requirements. State Firemen's & Fire Marshals' Assn. (SFFMA) does not offer Fire Officer III or IV certification.

Rural Volunteer Fire Department (VFD) Assistance Program (HB 2604)

- ♦ Training tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$85 per day, not to exceed \$595 per trainee per school.
- ♦ Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,000 per department per school.
- ♦ The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department

Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS)

- ♦ Training Tuition grants under this program will be provided up to a maximum of \$85 per day, not to exceed \$595 per trainee per school.
- ♦ Training tuition grants are limited to a maximum of \$6,000 per department per school.
- ♦ The maximum amount of Training Tuition assistance a department may receive in a fiscal year (September through August) is \$12,000.
